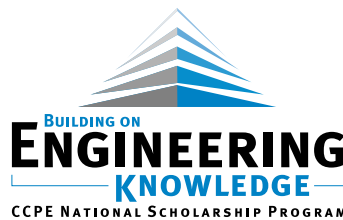
SCHOLARSHIP RECEPTION AND CEREMONY
