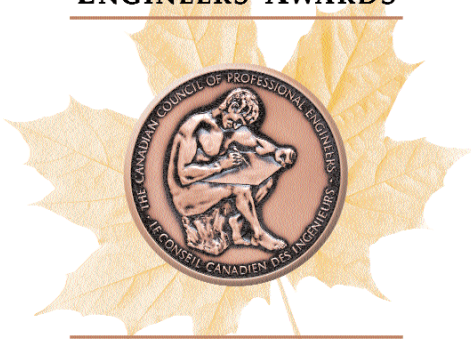

Garry Wacker, P.Eng.

Meritorious Service Award for Professional Service

Throughout his career, Garry Wacker, P.Eng., has been instrumental in raising society's awareness about the importance of engineering and the impact of technology on our day-to-day lives.

Wacker, who holds a MSc in Electrical Engineering from the University of Saskatchewan (U of S), became a professor at the U of S in 1963. Since this time, Professor Wacker has been a dedicated teacher, administrator and researcher. He is also a strong proponent for teaching the importance of engineering ethics and impacts of technology on society.

His research interests saw him take on projects related to biomedical applications, such as developing lasers for ophthalmic and biological surgery and babies' inter-cranial pressure measuring devices.

A published author of numerous research papers and publications, Wacker is also a recognized authority in the area of electric service reliability. He has even acted as a consultant for regulatory bodies, coroners, police agencies and insurance companies for safety and forensic investigations related to possible electrical faults.

In addition to his teaching and consulting work, Wacker has contributed immeasurably to his profession, demonstrating extreme commitment and leadership. He has been an active member of his provincial licensing body, the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of Saskatchewan (APEGS) and even served as the association's president. In recognition of his work to APEGS, he was awarded with the Distinguished Service Award.

He has also contributed to the Canadian Council of Professional Engineers (CCPE) and served as CCPE's chair as well as chair of the Canadian Engineering Qualifications Board. He is also past-chair of IEEE, the world's leading professional association for electrical and electronics engineers.

Additionally, he is actively involved with his community and has served on several volunteer and charitable organizations.

For his outstanding service to the profession, his countless work-related achievements and his service to the community, the Canadian Council of Professional Engineers is honored to present Professor Garry Wacker with the *Meritorious Service Award for Professional Service*.
