TD Insurance Meloche Monnex Léopold Nadeau Scholarship

The second recipient of the first Engineers Canada-TD Insurance Meloche Monnex Léopold Nadeau scholarship, Jason McCullough, P.Eng., will conduct workshops on local environmental and water resources applications in First Nation communities.

Pursuing a Master of Applied Science in Environmental Engineering, Jason's research aims to investigate First Nation perspectives on drinking water infrastructure implementation programs through interviewing water treatment plant operators, project managers, technical officers, community planners and band council members. His goal is to provide Canadian engineers with a deeper understanding of the water treatment challenges faced by First Nation operators; reduce health impacts on vulnerable groups; improve the quality of life and social conditions of First Nation communities; and encourage empowerment to influence policy.
